
Office Memorandum

**Subject: Information sought under RTI Act. 2005.**

The RTI Act.2005 invokes provision under Section 6(3) to enable one public authority to transfer the application to another or other public authorities if the information sought by the person under Section 6(1) pertains to more than one public authority. Since enactment of the RTI Act.2005, many public authorities have not yet registered themselves with the RTI web portal to enable the information seeker to apply online directly to that public authority or to transfer the online application received by one public authority to other public authority which substantially causes gross inconvenience both for the applicant and the public authority as the time and overhead expenses are consumed on transfer of application physically.

You are therefore, requested to sensitize the issue to promote all the concerned offices and stakeholders/Nodal officer/CPIOs to register themselves on DOPT online web portal and RTI Request & Appeal Management Information based on RTI Act.2005 at the earliest.
