- vi) The placement of the official for appointment in the above Ministry/ Department is provisional and may be changed, if necessary.



dated 14.09.1992 or in any subsequent instructions of the Government of India exist and ensuring that the official is not undergoing any penalty under CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 incorporating the terms and conditions in Para 2 above with a copy to this office.

4. The Departmentalized Accounts Office issuing promotion orders may also advise the above official that he can be debarred of promotion as per DoPT orders if he declines to accept promotion and thereby loose inter-se-seniority.

5. Refusal by individual to accept promotion will be subject to acceptance by this office.

6. The date of taking over as Private Secretary by the official may be intimated to this office.

Vasudevan will not be issued any fresh offer of appointment for promotion for a period of one year from the date of her refusal i.e. 29.06.2016 or till a vacancy arises, whichever is later.
